FISCAL NOTE

HB 1733 - SB 1829

February 1, 2014

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires certain business entities, pursuant to the Tennessee Business Corporation Act, to provide the Secretary of State (SOS) a mailing address, such as a post office box address, which is considered a deliverable address according to the United States Postal Service (USPS), when the USPS does not deliver mail to the business entity's physical address.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- Based on information provided by the SOS, the TN-BEAR computer system will require some minor modifications. However, any increase in state expenditures to perform such modifications is estimated to be not significant and can be accommodated within existing resources without an increased appropriation or a reduced reversion.
