FISCAL NOTE

HB 1894 - SB 2277

February 7, 2014

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires local education agencies (LEAs) to give \$100, of the current Basic Education Program (BEP) allotment of \$200, to each teacher for instructional supplies by August 1 of each academic year. Requires LEAs which do not disburse such funding to teachers by August 1 to send a detailed explanation of why the disbursement did not take place to the Education Committees of the General Assembly and the Commissioner of Education.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- No change in the BEP funding formula.
- Explanation by LEAs may be sent electronically.
- Any increase in state or local expenditures to send or receive explanation for failure to disburse funding is estimated to be not significant.
