HB 1936 - SB 2457

SUMMARY OF BILL: Specifies that any allegations against an assisted-care living facility or an investigator's, inspector's or surveyor's report may be public record before formal charges are filed against the provider of such facilities services.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- This will have no significant impact on the Department of Health or the Board for Licensing Health Care Facilities.
- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 4-29-121, all health related boards are required to be self-supporting over a two-year period. The Board for Licensing Health Care Facilities had closing balances of \$450,785 in FY11-12 and \$599,456 in FY12-13.
