**FISCAL NOTE**

**HB 2065 - SB 2348**

February 5, 2014

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Deletes obsolete state law that required the Department of Labor and Workforce Development to report, on or before January 1, 2014, to the Commerce and Labor Committee of the Senate and the Business and Utilities Committee of the House of Representatives on the findings and recommendations concerning the Tennessee Works program.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

- Any increase in state expenditures for the Tennessee Code Commission to remove obsolete state law from Tennessee Code Annotated is estimated to be not significant.
