FISCAL NOTE

HB 2313 - SB 2473

March 6, 2014

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the University of Tennessee's Howard H. Baker Jr. Center for Public Policy to perform a study on the economic feasibility of creating and utilizing a statewide comprehensive energy policy. Sets forth the study objectives. Authorizes the Baker Center to establish public and private partnerships to perform the study. Requires a report to be made to the Energy Task Force of the House of Representatives no later than October 1, 2014.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures - \$19,400/One-Time

Assumptions:

- The Baker Center will require one additional graduate assistant, at a cost of \$17,393, to help complete the study.
- The Baker Center estimates that travel costs while compiling information for the study will be \$2,000.
- The one-time increase in state expenditures is estimated to be \$19,393 (\$17,393 + \$2,000).
