HB 2400 - SB 2547

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the executive director of the Board of Pharmacy to consult with the Commissioner of Health when determining staffing of the controlled substance monitoring database.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- This will have no significant impact on the Department of Health or the Board of Pharmacy.
- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 4-29-121, all health related boards are required to be self-supporting over a two-year period. The Board of Pharmacy had closing balances of \$85,209 in FY11-12, \$296,813 in FY12-13, and a closing reserve balance of \$1,226,220 on June 30, 2013.
