SUMMARY OF BILL: Creates a special joint committee to study the monetary implications of the state's participation in various federal programs, the legal and fiscal impediments to reducing or eliminating the state's participation in the various federal programs, and the benefits and detriments to the state as a result of its participation in various federal programs, including but not limited to, the effects of participation on the sovereignty of the state over matters of public policy. Requires the Committee to report its findings and recommendations to the 108th General Assembly no later than February 1, 2014, at which time the Committee shall cease to exist.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures - \$3,000/Each One-Day Meeting

Assumption:

- Travel and per diem expenses for 10 legislative members of \$2,970 per meeting (\$173 per diem plus \$124 mileage for each member).
