SUMMARY OF BILL: Creates a special joint committee to study the establishment of a pilot program to offer comprehensive programs designed to provide resources to former law enforcement personnel and to help them achieve their educational and career goals. The Committee shall only schedule meetings to be held during times when the Committee members who are General Assembly members are eligible for travel reimbursement or to provide such members of the Committee with an option to attend the meetings virtually via video telecommunication services, subject to approval by the Speaker of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives. The Committee shall report its findings to the Senate Judiciary Committee and the Criminal Justice Committee of the House of Representatives by January 8, 2015, at which time the Committee shall cease to exist.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures - \$3,100/Each One-Day Meeting

Assumptions:

- Travel and per diem expenses for six legislative members of \$1,968 per meeting (\$188 per diem plus \$140 mileage for each member).
- Travel expenses for eight non-legislative members of \$1,120 per meeting (\$140 mileage for each member).
- Total expenses per meeting is \$3,088 (\$1,968 + \$1,120).
