FISCAL NOTE

SB 16 – HB 237

January 29, 2013

SUMMARY OF BILL: Prohibits employers, and employees of employers, who contract for services with a school, local board of education, or child care program, that have been convicted of a violent juvenile sexual offense, as classified by Tenn. Code Ann. § 40-39-202, from coming in direct contact with school children or children in a child care program or from entering a school or child care facility when children are present.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The provisions of this bill will not increase the number of background checks performed because background checks are required under current law for potential contract vendors of schools, boards of education, and child care programs.
- No fiscal impact on state or local government.
