SB 89 – HB 377

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the Alcoholic Beverage Commission (ABC) to promulgate rules and regulations to limit the number of high alcohol content products sold to one customer at a retail package store in one day, and to limit the number of such products sold to a customer for on-premises consumption on any one day.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- Customers are assumed to purchase substitute products if high alcohol content products are limited. Any net change in state or local government revenue is estimated to be not significant.
