FISCAL NOTE

SB 131

January 24, 2013

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires motor vehicle registration plates to be illuminated any time headlights are required to be displayed, on all motor vehicles that are factory-equipped to illuminate the plates. A violation is a Class C misdemeanor punishable by fine of \$10 for the first offense and \$20 for second or subsequent offenses.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Requiring motor vehicle registration plates to be illuminated any time headlights are required to be displayed, on all motor vehicles that are factory-equipped to illuminate the plates, will not have a significant fiscal impact on the Department of Safety, nor will it significantly impact the operations of the Highway Patrol.
- There will not be a sufficient number of prosecutions for state or local government to experience any significant increase in revenue or expenditures.
