FISCAL NOTE

SB 187 - HB 181

February 8, 2013

SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes the Department of Safety to promulgate rules and regulations regarding access to the P25 Interoperable Communications System, including the authority to collect assessment for the use and maintenance of the system. Requires any assessments to be considered expendable receipts of the Department for use in maintaining the system.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Other Fiscal Impact – There will be a recurring increase in state revenue to the Department of Safety of an unknown amount. All revenue will remain with the Department for the purpose of maintaining the P25 Interoperable Communications System.

Assumptions:

- The Department of Safety (DOS) will enter into agreements with users of the system.
- According to the DOS, no fee has been set and no determination has been made concerning how users would be charged.
- According to DOS, the number of agreements the Department will enter is unknown at this time.
- There will be a recurring increase in revenue to the DOS for the purpose of maintaining the system; however, the timing and the amount of such increase in state revenue is unknown.
- Any increase in expenditures related to entering into agreements with users will be not significant and will be recovered by the fees charged to the users.
