SB 320 – HB 774

SUMMARY OF BILL: Extends the termination date of the Board of Veterinarian Medical Examiners to June 30, 2017. Under the *Tennessee Governmental Entity Review Law*, the Board was scheduled to terminate on June 30, 2013.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- This bill continues an existing entity at its current funding level.
- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 4-3-1011, all health-related boards are required to be self-supporting over a two-year period. The Board had closing balances of \$80,638.25 in FY10-11 and \$84,379.61 in FY11-12. As of June 30, 2012, the Board's cumulative balance was \$180,989.95.
