SB 696 – HB 1075

February 19, 2013

SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes the chief executive of the largest city located within an urbanized area to develop a comprehensive hospital sign plan and deliver the plan to the Department of Transportation (TDOT) for its review.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Urbanized area is defined as any county having a population of 100,000 or greater according to the most recent federal census.
- TDOT's rule 1680-03-02-.18(2) authorizes an urbanized area's government to submit a comprehensive sign plan to the Commissioner of TDOT for consideration and possible approval of installation of hospital signs.
- Codifying the existing TDOT rule will not result in a significant fiscal impact to state or local governments.
