SB 851 - HB 940

SUMMARY OF BILL: Creates the Underground Utility Damage Prevention Advisory Committee for the purpose of studying and reporting on how Tennessee can best comply with federal law, rules and regulations for an effective damage prevention program. The committee would be required to report its findings to the Governor, Speaker of the Senate, Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the Comptroller of the Treasury no later than November 1, 2013.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Assumptions:

- Per the language of the bill, members of the committee will serve without compensation.
- According to the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (TRA), stakeholders have already been meeting to further the goals of the committee created by this bill and there will be no fiscal impact to TRA resulting from the provisions of this bill.
