SB 1090 - HB 929

March 6, 2013

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Requires the Historical Commission to conduct an audit of war memorials to ensure the appropriate individuals are listed on such memorials and to identify any memorials with substandard conditions. Requires the Commission to report its findings to the Finance, Ways and Means Committees of the Senate and House of Representatives and to develop a plan to remedy any problems discovered.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**Other Fiscal Impact – The FY12-13 appropriations bill included \$35,000 for the Historical Commission for the purpose of remedying any problems identified on war memorials. It is estimated that all funds will be expended for such purpose and no funds will revert back to the General Fund.**

Assumptions:

- Funding for the purpose of identifying and remedying any problems found on state war memorials was included in the FY12-13 appropriations act in the amount of \$35,000.
- It is estimated that such funds will be expended in total for any necessary remedies and no amount will revert back to the General Fund.
- According to Department of Environment and Conservation, the amount of \$35,000 is sufficient in performing the required audit and any subsequent remedy.
