**FISCAL NOTE**

**SB 1466 – HB 1727**

February 2, 2014

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Requires an organization intending to establish a recognized minor party solely within one county for the purpose of a primary or general election to file a petition that bears the signatures of registered voters within such county equal to at least 2.5 percent of the total number of votes cast within such county for gubernatorial candidates in the most recent election for Governor. Requires at least one candidate for the recognized minor party to have received a number of votes equal to five percent of the total votes cast for candidates for the Office of County Mayor in the most recent election for such office, if the recognized minor party has been established solely within one county.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

- According to the Secretary of State, there would be no significant impact on state or local government resulting from the proposed signature requirements.
