FISCAL NOTE

SB 1469 – HB 1705

February 13, 2014

SUMMARY OF BILL: Defines “biometric record”. Requires a state agency or education institution, unless mandated by federal statutes, to obtain written permission from parents or students, in the case of students who are over the age of 18, before collecting certain types of individual student data. Prohibits a state agency or educational institution from pursuing or accepting any grant, from the federal government or private entity, which requires the collecting or reporting of certain types of individual student data. Prohibits the adoption or administration of a state or national assessment that requires the collecting or reporting of certain types of individual student data.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The state will continue to contract with all outside vendors.
- No change in state education assessments.
- No change in grant funding received by higher education institutions.
- Any increase in state or local expenditures is estimated to be not significant.
