SB 1682 – HB 2253

February 22, 2014

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the State Board of Education (SBE) to adopt social studies and science curriculum that reflect the values of the state. Prohibits the SBE from joining a consortium or initiative that requires the adoption of common standards in social studies or science subjects.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The SBE will continue to be authorized to adopt standards that are created by a consortium or initiative.
- Any change in the state curriculum standards will be performed by the SBE in the normal course of SBE meetings.
- No change in Tennessee assessment or achievement tests.
