FISCAL NOTE

SB 1809 - HB 1808

February 9, 2014

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires all departments, agencies, commissions, subdivisions, and other entities of the State to follow opinions issued by the Attorney General until a court with proper jurisdiction overturns the opinion or the General Assembly enacts legislation that changes the law or laws that are the subject of the opinion.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- According to the Attorney General, the proposed legislation would not have a significant impact on the Attorney General.
- The proposed legislation could impact the State if an opinion required services for a class of citizens not currently provided services or if an opinion greatly restricted the application of a criminal statute. However, there is neither a reasonable method, nor sufficient information, to reasonably determine whether the proposed legislation would significantly impact the State.
- It is assumed that the proposed legislation will not significantly impact the State.
