FISCAL NOTE

SB 1940 - HB 1871

February 6, 2014

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires local education agencies (LEAs) within counties that have certain teen pregnancy rates to send additional information on the LEAs' family life curriculum to the state. Requires such LEAs to send a list of their specific family life curriculum, and information about the person, non-LEA employee, or organization that teaches the course, to the Department of Education (DOE) and the State Board of Education (SBE).

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- LEAs may send this information to the DOE and SBE electronically. Any increase in local government expenditures is estimated to be not significant.
- Any increase in state expenditures for additional record keeping is estimated to be not significant.
