**SB 1994 - HB 1905**

March 4, 2014

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Requires that a police officer's beneficiary shall receive the state cash salary supplement if the officer does not complete the in-service training program due to the officer's death.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

On March 3, 2014, a fiscal note was issued estimating a fiscal impact as follows:

*Increase State Expenditures - \$3,000*

Upon additional review, this impact was in error. The estimated impact is:

**Increase State Expenditures - \$1,200**

Assumptions:

- Currently, an officer must complete eight months of full-time service as a law-enforcement officer during the calendar year and at least 40 hours of in-service training to receive the state cash salary supplement.
- The cash salary supplement is \$600 per year.
- It is estimated that the beneficiaries of two deceased officers will each receive the \$600 supplement, resulting in an increase in state expenditures of \$1,200 per year (2 x \$600).
