SB 2078 - HB 2091

March 3, 2014

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the Douglas Henry State Museum Commission to include as an ex officio, nonvoting member, the president of the Tennessee Historical Society or the president's designee, whose term shall begin on July 1, 2015.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

On February 8, 2014, a fiscal note was issued estimating a fiscal impact as follows:

*Increase State Expenditures - \$500/FY15-16 and Subsequent Years/
Douglas Henry State Museum Commission*

Additional information was received from the Tennessee Historical Society. The fiscal note is being corrected to reflect this information. The fiscal impact is as follows:

Other Fiscal Impact - According to the Tennessee Historical Society (THS), it will reimburse all costs incurred by the state for the THS president to attend the Douglas Henry State Museum Commission meetings.


Corrected assumptions:

- The state reimburses members of the Commission for all necessary expenses incurred in attending to the necessary duties of the Commission.
- The Commission meets four times per year. One of these four meetings is held outside Davidson County.
- According to the Commission, average annual reimbursements per member include \$100 in per diem and miscellaneous supplies and \$350 in travel expenses.
- Beginning in FY15-16, one new member will result in a recurring increase in state expenditures of \$450 (\$100 + \$350).
- According to the Tennessee Historical Society, it will reimburse any and all costs to the state for the THS president to attend the Douglas Henry State Museum Commission meetings.
