SB 2098 - HB 2205

March 18, 2014

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the Department of Revenue to provide a free decal that may be affixed to any license plate to designate that the driver is a disabled veteran. Individuals with such decal affixed would be eligible for the same parking privileges as the holder of a disabled driver placard.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

On February 4, 2014, a fiscal note was issued for this bill with an estimated fiscal impact as follows:

Increase State Expenditures - \$500/FY14-15 and Every Five Years Thereafter

Based upon additional information provided by the Department of Revenue, the fiscal impact for the bill has been corrected as follows.
