SJR 103

SUMMARY OF BILL: Proposes amending Article III, Section 12 of the Constitution of Tennessee to establish authority to exercise powers and duties of the Governor, if the Governor is unable to perform such duties. Requires the resolution be published in compliance with Article XI, Section 3 of the Constitution of Tennessee.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures – \$9,100/One-Time

Assumptions:

- The Secretary of State will publish the proposed amendment at least six months prior to the next election of General Assembly members, scheduled for November 2014.
- Based on information provided by the Secretary of State, the one-time increase in state expenditures for publishing costs is estimated to be \$9,100. The one-time state expenditure will occur in FY13-14.
