AMEND Senate Bill No. 1160

House Bill No. 754*

by deleting all language after the enacting clause and substituting instead the following:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 40-39-202, is amended by deleting subdivisions (20)(A)(iii) and (30)(X) in their entireties.

SECTION 2. Any person who is currently mandated to comply with the requirements of this part or part 3 of this chapter, based solely upon a conviction of aggravated prostitution, under § 39-13-516, shall, upon the effective date of this act, no longer be required to comply or considered a sexual offender or violent sexual offender. The Tennessee bureau of investigation shall automatically remove any person who is no longer required to comply pursuant to this act from the sexual offender registry and shall not require the person to submit a request for termination of registry requirements.

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 39-13-516, is amended by deleting subsection (d) and substituting instead the following:

(d) Aggravated prostitution is a Class C felony; provided, however, that, notwithstanding § 40-35-303, a court shall order the offender to participate in a six-year term of supervised probation following any period of confinement imposed. An offender who violates the conditions of probation imposed by the court shall be subject to revocation or modification of the probation in the discretion of the court.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 2015, the public welfare requiring it, and unless otherwise prohibited by the United States or Tennessee constitution, it is
