AMEND Senate Bill No. 2207

House Bill No. 2112*

by deleting SECTION 2 and substituting instead the following:

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-4-253(a), is amended by deleting the subsection and substituting instead the following:

(a)

(1) An owner or lessee of a motor vehicle who is a resident of this state and who is an honorably discharged veteran of the United States armed forces, or a civilian veteran of the United States army corps of engineers, upon complying with state motor vehicle laws relating to registration and licensing of motor vehicles and upon payment of any applicable fees pursuant to this subsection (a), shall be issued an honorably discharged veteran registration plate for a motor vehicle authorized by § 55-4-210(c). A surviving spouse of such a deceased honorably discharged veteran, upon complying with state motor vehicle laws relating to registration and licensing of motor vehicles, upon paying the regular fee applicable to the vehicle and the fee prescribed by § 55-4-203, and upon providing a copy of the death certificate of the deceased honorably discharged veteran, shall be issued a registration plate pursuant to this section, until the surviving spouse remarries.

(2) Registration plates issued pursuant to this section may be obtained by any eligible person upon payment of the regular registration fee for plates, as prescribed under § 55-4-111, and payment of the fee provided for in § 55-4-203(c)(1).

(3) Notwithstanding subdivision (a)(2), registration plates issued to any person who served in combat and is eligible for a plate under subdivision (c)(4)(A), (c)(5)(A), (c)(6)(A), (c)(7)(A), (c)(8)(A), (c)(10)(A), or (c)(12)(A), may be obtained upon payment of one-half (1/2) the regular registration fee for plates, as prescribed under § 55-4-111, and payment of one-half (1/2) the fee provided for in § 55-4-203(c)(1).
