**AMEND Senate Bill No. 320\***

**House Bill No. 289**

by deleting subdivision (a)(1) in SECTION 3 and substituting the following::

(1) There is created the Tennessee state medical examiner advisory council. The council shall consist of twenty (20) members, each of whom shall be a resident of this state. The governor shall appoint two (2) members from each regional forensic center, three (3) county medical examiners that are not forensic pathologists and are not employees of the health department, one (1) representative from the district attorneys conference, one (1) representative from the Tennessee bureau of investigation, one (1) representative from the Tennessee association of chiefs of police, one (1) representative from the association of county mayors, one (1) representative from the Tennessee sheriffs' association, one (1) consumer member to represent the interests of the public, and the state chief medical examiner, who shall serve as chair and as an ex-officio voting member.
