**AMEND Senate Bill No. 2376**

**House Bill No. 1736\***

by adding the language "or agencies" between the language "law enforcement agency" and the language "with jurisdiction" in subdivision (9)(B)(i) of the amendatory language of SECTION 1.

**AND FURTHER AMEND** by deleting the language "the law enforcement agency" in the first sentence of subdivision (9)(B)(ii) in the amendatory language of SECTION 1 and substituting instead "any law enforcement agency".

**AND FURTHER AMEND** by deleting the punctuation "." at the end of the first sentence in subdivision (9)(B)(ii) of the amendatory language of SECTION 1 and substituting instead:

; except that the employee's name and other information may be disclosed to an administrative officer of the institution who is responsible for school facility security; provided, however, that the administrative officer is not the employee's immediate supervisor or a supervisor responsible for evaluation of the employee. An administrative officer to whom such information is disclosed shall not disclose the information to another person.

**AND FURTHER AMEND** by deleting subdivision (e)(10) in its entirety and substituting instead:

(A) Any employee of the University of Tennessee institute of agriculture or a college or department of agriculture at a campus in the University of Tennessee system when in the discharge of the employee's official duties and with prior authorization from the chancellor of the University of Tennessee institute of agriculture; or

(B) Any employee of the University of Tennessee institute of agriculture or a college or department of agriculture at a campus in the University of Tennessee system, and any member of the employee's household, living in a residence owned, used, or

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operated by the University of Tennessee, if the employee has prior authorization from the chancellor of the University of Tennessee institute of agriculture and the employee and household members are permitted to possess firearms in their residence under Tennessee and federal law; and
