**AMEND Senate Bill No. 1859\***

**House Bill No. 2026**

by deleting all language after the enacting clause and substituting instead the following:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 40-32-101, is amended by adding the following as a new subsection:

(k) The Tennessee bureau of investigation shall study and determine the number of Class E felony offenses committed in each year of the five (5) preceding years that would be eligible for expunction under subdivision (g)(1)(A) if the corresponding ranges listed in subdivision (g)(1)(A) were removed. By June 1, 2017, the Tennessee bureau of investigation shall submit a report on the average yearly number of such felonies to the criminal justice committee of the house of representatives and the judiciary committee of the senate.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
