AMEND Senate Bill No. 1158

House Bill No. 776*

by deleting in § 47-18-2111(a)(1)(A) the language “eighteen (18) years of age” and substituting instead the language “sixteen (16) years of age”.

AND FURTHER AMEND by deleting in the first sentence of § 47-18-2111(b) the language “the use of a protected consumer’s consumer report or record by”.

AND FURTHER AMEND by deleting the following language in § 47-18-2111(g) and renumbering the remaining subdivisions appropriately:

- (1) The protected consumer attains eighteen (18) years of age;

AND FURTHER AMEND by deleting in § 47-18-2111(j)(2) the language “exceeding five dollars (\$5.00)” and substituting instead the language “exceeding ten dollars (\$10.00)”.

AND FURTHER AMEND by deleting in § 47-18-2111(j)(3)(B) the language “eighteen (18) years of age” and substituting instead the language “sixteen (16) years of age”.

AND FURTHER AMEND by deleting § 47-18-2111(l) in its entirety and substituting instead the following:

- (l) The sole power to enforce violations of this section shall be with the attorney general.

AND FURTHER AMEND by deleting in § 47-18-2111(m) the language “eighteen (18) years of age” wherever it appears and substituting instead the language “sixteen (16) years of age”.

AND FURTHER AMEND by deleting in Section 4 the language “Sections 1 and 2 of this act” and substituting instead the language “Section 1 of this act”.

AND FURTHER AMEND by deleting Section 2 in its entirety and renumbering the remaining Sections appropriately.
