AMEND Senate Bill No. 1033

House Bill No. 539*

by deleting all language after the enacting clause and substituting instead the following:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 68, Chapter 5, Part 1, is amended by adding the following as a new section to be appropriately designated:

(a) As used in this section, "CMV" means cytomegalovirus.

(b) A healthcare provider, as defined by § 63-6-703, who assumes responsibility for the prenatal care of pregnant women during gestation or women who may become pregnant, shall inform those women who, in the discretion of the healthcare provider, are at risk of the disease regarding:

(1) The incidence of CMV;

(2) The transmission of CMV to at-risk women who are pregnant or who may become pregnant;

(3) Birth defects caused by congenital CMV;

(4) Methods of diagnosing congenital CMV; and

(5) Available preventive measures.

(c) Healthcare providers as described in subsection (b) are encouraged to provide all other patients with information where the patients can learn about CMV.

(d)

(1) Nothing in this section shall be construed to create or impose liability for failing to comply with the requirements of this section.

(2) Nothing in this section shall be deemed to create a duty of care or other legal obligation beyond the information set forth in this section.

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SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2015, the public welfare requiring it.
