**AMEND Senate Joint Resolution No. 93\***

by deleting the period at the end of the first resolving clause and substituting instead the following:

; provided, that the Insure Tennessee waiver request includes or complies with the following: a lockout provision for nonpayment of premiums that is substantially similar to lockout provisions approved by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services for a waiver for the state of Indiana; a memorandum of understanding to the General Assembly executed by the Governor asserting that Insure Tennessee will not be implemented until the United States Supreme Court decides the case of *King v. Burwell* (Docket No. 14-114); and the Governor receives written confirmation from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services that the State has an opt-out that the State may exercise if the program develops expenses to the State beyond those covered by federal funds and hospital assessment funds.
