

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 758

A RESOLUTION to confirm the appointment of Dr. Kenneth C. Hill as a director of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority.

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 65-1-101, creates the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (TRA); and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 65-1-101(a), provides that one director of the TRA shall be appointed by the speaker of the senate; and

WHEREAS, Speaker of the Senate Ron Ramsey has reappointed Dr. Kenneth C. Hill of Blountville to serve a six-year term as a director of the TRA, such term to expire on June 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Hill has previously served as chairman of the TRA and is also active with the National Association of Regulatory Utility Commissioners (NARUC) and the Southeastern Association of Regulatory Utility Commissioners (SEARUC); and

WHEREAS, during his tenure with the TRA, Dr. Hill has also served as a member of the Tennessee State Information Systems Council, member of the Board of the Organization of PJM States, Inc. (OPSI), member of the Eastern Interconnection States' Planning Council (EISPC), delegate to the 5th World Forum on Energy Regulation (WFER), and Tennessee Team Member of the National Governors' Association Policy Academy on Enhancing Industry through Energy Efficiency and Combined Heat and Power; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 65-1-101(f), provides that each appointment to the TRA shall be confirmed by Joint Resolution of the General Assembly; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE HUNDRED NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE SENATE CONCURRING, that we hereby confirm the appointment of Dr. Kenneth C. Hill of Blountville to serve a six-year term as a director of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority, such term to expire on June 30, 2020.
