

SENATE BILL 637

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 40,
relative to diversion of criminal proceedings.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 40-35-313(a)(1)(B)(iii), is amended
by redesignating the current subdivision as (a)(1)(B)(iii)(a) and adding the following as

(a)(1)(B)(iii)(b):

(b) As used in this subsection (a), "reasonable conditions" also includes, but is
not limited to, the requirement that a qualified defendant serve a period of confinement
of not more than eleven (11) months, twenty-nine (29) days in the local jail or
workhouse. The court may permit any term of confinement to be split confinement,
pursuant to § 40-35-306, or periodic confinement, pursuant to § 40-35-307.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2015, the public welfare requiring it.
