

SENATE BILL 1006

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 5;  
Title 6; Title 7 and Title 55, Chapter 8, relative to  
certain traffic enforcement cameras.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-8-198, is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated subsection:

(o)

(1) On and after July 1, 2015, no municipality having a population of not less than one thousand seven hundred thirty (1,730) nor more than one thousand seven hundred thirty-nine (1,739), according to the 2010 federal census or any subsequent federal census, shall place or operate an unmanned traffic enforcement camera in a location where the municipality has extended its corporate limits by means of corridor annexation of a public right-of-way or any easement owned by a governmental entity or quasi-governmental entity but has not annexed parcels of property contiguous to the right-of-way, easement, or corridor on both sides of the entire length of the corridor annexation.

(2) This subsection (o) shall only apply to contracts entered into, amended, or renewed on or after July 1, 2015.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
