

SENATE RESOLUTION 3

A RESOLUTION to confirm the appointment of Crawford Gallimore of Martin to the Board of Trustees of the University of Tennessee.

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-9-202, provides for the creation of the Board of Trustees of the University of Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-9-202, further provides that the Governor shall appoint twenty-two members to the board; and

WHEREAS, Governor Bill Haslam has appointed Crawford Gallimore of Martin to a term as a board member of the Board of Trustees of the University of Tennessee representing the Weakley County District; Mr. Gallimore will serve on the board during a term that will expire on May 31, 2020; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Gallimore is the principal and chief financial officer for the Hamilton-Ryker Group, and serves as the president of the Martin Rotary Club and the Weakley County Chamber of Commerce, as well as chair of the Board of Trustees at Volunteer Community Hospital; and

WHEREAS, a long-standing supporter of the University of Tennessee, Crawford Gallimore has served on the University of Tennessee Board of Trustees, the University of Tennessee Development Council, the University of Tennessee at Martin College of Business and Public Affairs Advisory Board, and the University of Tennessee College of Business Advisory Council to the Dean; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Gallimore is a person of integrity and an active citizen whose benevolence, acumen, and strong commitment to public service have helped to enhance the well-being of this State and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-9-202, provides that each member appointed by the Governor to the Board of Trustees of the University of Tennessee shall be confirmed by Senate Resolution of the General Assembly; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, that this body does hereby confirm the appointment of Crawford Gallimore to the Board of Trustees of the University of Tennessee for a term to expire on May 31, 2020.
