

SENATE RESOLUTION 5

A RESOLUTION to confirm the appointment of Shannon Brown of Memphis to the Board of Trustees of the University of Tennessee.

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-9-202, provides for the creation of the Board of Trustees of the University of Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-9-202, further provides that the Governor shall appoint twenty-two members to the board; and

WHEREAS, Governor Bill Haslam has appointed Shannon Brown of Memphis to a term as a board member of the Board of Trustees of the University of Tennessee representing the Shelby County District; Mr. Brown will serve on the board during a term that will expire on May 31, 2020; and

WHEREAS, Shannon Brown is the senior vice president and chief human resources and diversity officer for FedEx Express; in addition, he serves on the March of Dimes Board of Trustees and the Lausanne Collegiate School Board of Trustees, is the chair of the board of directors of United Way of the Mid-South, and is a member of the central board of the Boys & Girls Clubs of Greater Memphis; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Brown is a person of integrity and an active citizen whose benevolence, acumen, and strong commitment to public service have helped to enhance the well-being of this State and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-9-202, provides that each member appointed by the Governor to the Board of Trustees of the University of Tennessee shall be confirmed by Senate Resolution of the General Assembly; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, that this body does hereby confirm the appointment of Shannon Brown to the Board of Trustees of the University of Tennessee for a term to expire on May 31, 2020.
