FISCAL MEMORANDUM

HB 414 – SB 540

March 3, 2015

SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL: Authorizes the board of commissioners for any incorporated city, pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. Title 6, Chapters 18 through 22, to enact ordinances by using consent calendars.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (003811): Adds language to the bill that (1) requiring an adopted amendment to an ordinance on the consent calendar be removed when a board member objects to the amendment being on the consent calendar, and (2) a requirement that copies of the consent calendar and agenda be published prior to any meeting at which the consent calendar will be considered.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

Assumptions for the bill as amended:

- Incorporated cities impacted by this bill as amended can enact ordinances under current law pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 6-20-215(a).
- Under the provisions of this bill as amended, the incorporated cities can enact ordinances pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 6-20-215(a), or by use of a consent calendar.
- The number of enacted ordinances will not change as a result of the bill.
- The provisions of any enacted ordinance will not change as a result of this bill.
- Any additional cost to publish a consent calendar as required is estimated to be not significant and can be accomplished utilizing existing resources.
