FISCAL MEMORANDUM

HB 1302 – SB 1374

March 10, 2015

SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL: Authorizes the fines collected pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 39-13-111 relative to domestic assault to be used to pay for global positioning monitoring systems for domestic assault or stalking offenders as a condition of bail.

Authorizes a judge to use the funds to pay for an indigent defendant's GPS monitoring.

Requires courts to have forms with a space to indicate whether GPS monitoring was considered as a condition of bail and whether or not it as imposed.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (003834): Deletes provision authorizing fines from domestic assault cases to be used to pay for GPS monitoring for domestic assault or stalking offenders as a condition of bail.

Deletes provision authorizing a judge to use funds to pay for an indigent defendant's GPS monitoring.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

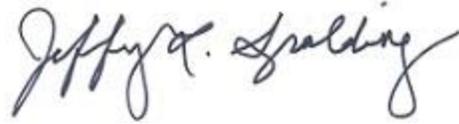
Assumptions for the bill as amended:
