FISCAL MEMORANDUM

HB 904 – SB 1088

March 16, 2015

SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL: Prohibits the State Board of Education (SBE) from denying administrative licensure to principals on the basis that such individuals graduated from a college or university degree program that is located outside of Tennessee.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (004438): Deletes all language of the original bill. Prohibits the State Board of Education (SBE) from denying an instructional leader a license solely on the basis that such applicant completed a leadership preparation program located outside Tennessee.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

Assumptions for the bill as amended:

- Tennessee does not charge a fee for the issuance or renewal of a teaching or administrative license.
- The SBE will update its policies to reflect this change in the normal course of SBE meetings without an increase in personnel or a reduction in its reversion to the General Fund
