FISCAL MEMORANDUM

SB 1271 – HB 1355

March 17, 2015

**SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL:** Authorizes the Department of Safety (DOS) to use its discretion to accept other official military discharge or separation papers, instead of only a certified copy of a department of defense form 214 (DD 214), from a Tennessee veteran requesting to have language or a symbol placed on their driver license or photo identification card reflecting their military service.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

**SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (004412):** Deletes all language of the original bill. Authorizes a foster parent or an authorized representative of the Department of Children's Services to sign the application for a driver's license or instructional permit for an individual under the age of 18.

**FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:**

Assumptions for the bill as amended:

- The Department of Safety and the Department of Children's Services both confirm this bill will have no fiscal impact on departmental operations.
