FISCAL MEMORANDUM

HB 480 – SB 1201

March 17, 2015

**SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL:** Prohibits private clubs in Davidson County from locating within 1,000 feet of a child care center, private school, public school, charter school, public park, or place of worship upon two-thirds vote of the county legislative body.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

**SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (004262):** Deletes all language of the original bill. Defines private club as a club or organization that operates for the purpose of providing members of the club with the opportunity to engage in or view live specified sexual activities; authorizes Davidson County to prohibit private clubs from locating within 1,000 feet of child care center, private school, public school, charter school, public park, or place of worship; specifically exempts adult-oriented businesses from the provisions of the bill; designates reserved section of code for the provisions of the amended bill.

**FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:**
