FISCAL MEMORANDUM

SB 522 – HB 820

March 23, 2015

SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL: Reduces from “within 60 days” to “within 45 days” the maximum time period that a board of commissioners for a utility district has to name nominees for the purpose of filling a vacancy on the board caused by death, resignation, disability, or forfeiture of office.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

IMPACT TO COMMERCE OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (004108): Deletes and rewrites the bill in its entirety. Requires vacancies on the utility district vacancy board to be filled within 60 days. Requires utility district to notify the county mayor each year by January 31 of the beginning and ending of each of the district utility board’s members’ terms of office.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

Assumption for the bill as amended:

- These reporting and appointment requirements will not have a significant fiscal impact on the utility district or the local governments which operate them.

IMPACT TO COMMERCE WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

Assumption for the bill as amended:

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- These reporting and appointment requirements for the purpose of filling a vacancy or informing the county mayor are not anticipated to result in any significant impact to commerce.
