FISCAL MEMORANDUM

HJR 529

February 5, 2016

SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL: Expresses the General Assembly's disagreement with the constitutional analysis in *Obergefell v. Hodges* and the judicial imposition of a marriage license law that is contrary to the express will of the body and the vote of the people of Tennessee.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (011974): Deletes all language after the caption. Expresses the General Assembly's disagreement with the constitutional overreach in *Obergefell v. Hodges*. Resolves that the General Assembly concurs with the opinion of Chief Justice John Roberts.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

Assumption for the bill as amended:

- Preparing an appropriate copy of the resolution will not result in a significant fiscal impact and can be accommodated within the existing resources of the General Assembly without an increased appropriation.
