FISCAL MEMORANDUM

HB 1890 – SB 2573

February 20, 2016

SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL: Removes the statutes governing issuance and service of summonses and service by publication for juvenile court rules. Requires the clerk to schedule a hearing and issue summons to the parties after a petition has been filed.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (012275): Deletes the words “post office” in subsection (a) of Section 5 and inserts the word “postal”.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

Assumptions for the bill as amended:

- According to the Administrative Office of the Courts, the Juvenile Court Rules are being revised simultaneously to remove much substantive law from them to be placed in the statute and as much procedural law as can be is being removed from the statute to be included in the rules. The proposed legislation accomplishes some of the necessary changes.
- Based on information provided by the Department of Children’s Services, the proposed legislation will have no effect on the programs or operations on the Department; any fiscal impact will be not significant.
