FISCAL MEMORANDUM

HB 2509 – SB 2493

February 19, 2016

SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL: Prohibits an administrator, professor, or employee of a public institution of higher education from requiring a student or employee to provide information on firearm ownership, or from taking adverse disciplinary or employment action against a student or employee of the institution, for any information voluntarily provided on firearm ownership.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (011678): Deletes and rewrites the bill such that the only substantive change is to remove Section 1 (c) of the bill which prohibited an administrator, professor, or employees from taking adverse disciplinary or employment action against a student or employee if information on firearm ownership was provided voluntarily.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

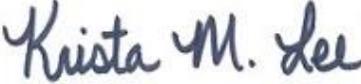
Assumptions for the bill as amended:

- The number of inquiries for information and the number of adverse disciplinary actions that the provisions of this bill will impact are estimated to be not significant.
- Based on the information provided by the Department of Safety and the Tennessee Higher Education Commission, there will be no change in operations or personnel as a result of this bill.
- Any fiscal impact on state or local government is estimated to be not significant.
