FISCAL MEMORANDUM

HB 1121 – SB 1144

March 7, 2016

SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL: Requires the Department of Education (DOE)'s list of priority schools in the state report card to list the schools by county; to rank the schools in each county by composite proficiency rate from high to low. Prohibits the placement of a school into the Achievement School District (ASD) until all lower ranked schools within a county have been placed in the ASD.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

Other Fiscal Impact – The amount of state and local Basic Education Program (BEP) funding that will shift from local education agencies (LEAs) to the ASD may change as a result of different schools being placed into the ASD. The extent of any such change cannot be reasonably quantified and is dependent upon multiple unknown factors.

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (013434): Deletes all language of the original bill. Requires the Department of Education's list of priority schools to list such schools' success rate from highest to lowest statewide and to list all such schools in each county and in each local education agency in order by success rate from highest to lowest.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption for the bill as amended:

- The DOE will include this information on its list of priority schools in the normal course of business without a significant increase in state expenditures.
