FISCAL MEMORANDUM

SB 2165 – HB 2490

March 12, 2016

SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL: Changes, from July 1 to September 1 of each year, the date by which the Department of Education (DOE) is required to submit its annual report on virtual schools to the Governor, the General Assembly, and the Basic Education Program (BEP) Review Committee.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (013620): Deletes all language of the original bill. Encourages students attending a public high school to volunteer at least 10 hours each semester. Requires public high schools to recognize students who complete community service at graduation. Requires the State Board of Education (SBE) to promulgate rules and regulations for these requirements.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

Assumption for the bill as amended:

- Any increase in local expenditures to recognize such students at graduation is estimated to be not significant and would be permissive.
