FISCAL MEMORANDUM

HB 458 – SB 513

March 15, 2016

**SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL:** Encourages non-resident students at Tennessee public colleges and universities to receive immunization against meningococcal disease. Non-resident students shall not be required to show proof of immunization for admission.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

**SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (013660):** Deletes all language of the original bill. Exempts new students at public higher education institutions who will reside in on-campus housing, who provide proof of prior or current military service, from providing the institution proof of immunization against meningococcal disease.

**FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:**

**Unchanged from the original fiscal note.**

Assumptions for the bill as amended:

- Any fiscal impact resulting from fewer records being kept in electronic or physical storage is estimated to be not significant.
- No fiscal impact on the higher education funding formula.
